**(U//LES) Anarchist Advocates Adopting the St. Paul Principles for Occupy
Chicago**

(U//LES) An individual involved in anarchist activity in Chicago, Illinois, has advocated enacting the St. Paul Principles as a guide for the conduct of Occupy Chicago participants.

(U) The St. Paul Principles were adopted by individuals who were opposed to, and attempted to use violence to disrupt the 2008 Republican National Convention (RNC) held in Minneapolis - St. Paul, Minnesota.

(U) The initial groups agreeing on the St. Paul Principles were the RNC Welcoming Committee, the Coalition to March on the RNC and Stop the War, the Anti-War Committee, Students for a Democratic Society - University of Minnesota, Communities United Against Police Brutality, the Welfare Rights Committee and Unconventional Action - Chicago.

(U) The St Paul Principles are:

(U) Law Enforcement Sensitive: This information is the property of the FBI and may be distributed to state, tribal, or local government law enforcement officials with a need-to-know. Further distribution without FBI authorization is prohibited. Precautions should be taken to ensure this information is stored and/or destroyed in a manner that precludes unauthorized access.

It is being shared for informational purposes but has not been fully evaluated, integrated with other information, interpreted, or analyzed. (U) 1. Our solidarity will be based on respect for a diversity of tactics and the plans of other groups;

(U) 2. The actions and tactics used will be organized to maintain a separation of time or space;

(U) 3. Any debates or criticisms will stay internal to the movement, avoiding any public or media denunciations of fellow activists and events; and

(U) 4. We oppose any state repression of dissent, including surveillance, infiltration, disruption and violence. We agree not to assist law enforcement actions against activists and others.

(U//LES) Based on the call to adopt the St. Paul Principles as the code of conduct for Occupy Chicago, it appears that an attempt is being made to influence the agenda and guidelines currently agreed upon by the Occupy Chicago General Assembly.

(U) This information is provided for the situational awareness of law enforcement and to promote public safety.
